Priorities 2022:

1. Missional Living

Putting missional living as a priority means we want to grow in three distinct ways. We want to grow in ourselves and our own ability to be missional in everything we do, we want to create opportunities to be missional to our local community and we want to be missional to other places across the world. We have several ideas for 2022:

- a. House churches to engage with their 'neighbours' quarterly on a 5th Sunday.
- b. Focus September as Mission Month in the Parish.
- c. Create a missional community around the idea of childcare so parents can have a date and alongside this offer parents coffee in the morning before school.

2. Children and Families Ministry

This is about developing this aspect of our church this year. We want All Saints to be intergenerational and at present the gap we can see clearly is children and families. This is not saying the other age groups are not important but rather helps us focus on developing this as a first instance. These are some of our ideas around this:

- a. Develop the 10.30am Childrens Church Offering
- b. Create spaces where parents can be taught how to disciple kids.
- c. Engage with community groups that offer services to Children and Families, and engage with families in our community.

3. Future Buildings

We need to start thinking about the future of this place. We can see the centre (which is a huge income stream for us) is looking tired, so how do we focus on maintaining that and then we also need to have a discussion as a church around what the future of the brick building is and what is needed for future ministry here. Here are our two projects around this idea:

- a. Revitalisation programme of the Parish Centre.
- b. Parish conversation about buildings and the brick building.
